Louise listed 5 key ways the passion to excel as a Lion can be achieved:

1. **Serve.** Lions Clubs exist to “serve the public” the District Governor said. She also injected that the Falmouth Club, in particular, is accomplishing this very well.
2. **Grow.** Louis discussed the “Plus 1” goal. Each Club should net one
